



### DESCRIPTION

As part of our strategic roadmap, *SHIFT305*, the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) is working to deliver projects and services that are safe, clean, efficient, and connected for all our residents. Improvements to South Bayshore Drive will deliver a safer and better-connected shared-use path for area residents, the cycling community, and commuters.

### OVERALL BENEFITS

- Providing a safer route for pedestrians and bicyclists.
- Providing high emphasis crosswalks.
- Improving the drainage system with a new pump station and improving water quality for Biscayne Bay.
- Installing a new pump station to mitigate flooding and improve the water quality for Biscayne Bay preserving the character of the road.
- Improving the corridor's lighting.
- Relocating existing trees as feasible as well as planting new trees within the limits of the project.
- Improving traffic operations and safety by installing a new signal at Darwin Street, upgrading mast arms, adding left turn lanes, and extending the existing left turn bays to increase storage capacity. Adding new pavement markings and signage.
- Reconstructing the road.
- Zero Right-Of-Way acquisition.
- Zero impacts to historical features.

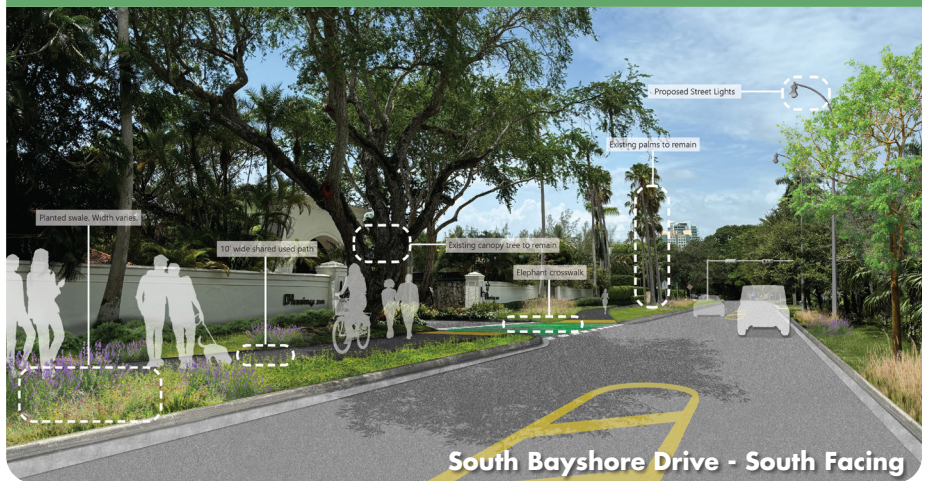

### SHARED-USE PATH BENEFITS

- Providing connectivity to The Commodore Trail (Shared-Use Path to Shared-Use Path).
- Providing continuity to the proposed Segments 2 and 4 of the Commodore Trail master plan.
- Providing connection to Kennedy Park from a Shared-Use Path.
- Minimizing impacts to existing trees by meandering the path.
- Separating the most vulnerable users (bicyclist and pedestrians) from vehicular traffic.
